- You will receive ORIGINAL C5360-2 form on the plane before arriving to Japan.
 Normally the cabin crew will give you only one form, so please ask them to give you two.
- 2. You will fill out both forms, and then you will submit them to Japanese Customs after picking up your suitcase in the airport.
 - *This is the normal process that all passengers need to do before leaving from the airport.
- 3. When you submit two forms to Customs, they will stamp on both two forms. The one would be for them, and the other one, which will need to submit us later, would be given back to you in order to send it to us by post.
