

- You will receive ORIGINAL C5360-2 form on the plane before arriving to Japan.
Normally the cabin crew will give you only one form, so please ask them to give you two.
- You will fill out both forms, and then you will submit them to Japanese Customs after picking up your suitcase in the airport.
*This is the normal process that all passengers need to do before leaving from the airport.
- When you submit two forms to Customs, they will stamp on both two forms.
The one would be for them, and the other one, which will need to submit us later, would be given back to you in order to send it to us by post.

◎ PROHIBITED ARTICLES

- Narcotic drugs, stimulants, marijuana, psychotropic substances, MDMA etc.
- Firearms such as Pistols revolvers and machineguns, and bullets or parts thereof.
- Explosives (dynamite etc), materials for chemical weapons.
- Counterfeit, altered or imitated bank notes, coins or securities, and forged credit cards.
- Obscene or immoral materials, and Child pornography.
- Articles which infringe upon intellectual property rights. (patent, utility model, design, trademark, copyright, neighboring right, etc.)

◎ RESTRICTED ARTICLES

- Hunting guns, air guns, swords, etc.
- Internationally protected endangered animals, plants, or their products. (crocodiles, Cobras, Turtles, ivory, musk, cactus, etc.)
- Live animals and plants, meat products (including sausage etc), vegetables, fruits, rice etc. (Quarantine inspection is required prior to Customs inspection.)

◎ Duty-Free Allowance for Non-residents

- 3 bottles (760ml/bottle) of alcoholic beverages,
- 400 cigarettes (Please inquire a Customs officer if you are a Japanese resident.)
* There is no duty-free allowances for alcoholic beverages and tobacco products for those under 20 years old.
- 2 ounces of Perfume
- Goods for personal use that were purchased abroad with a total market value not exceeding ¥200,000.
* As for children under 6 years old, duty-free allowances is limited to the articles owned for their personal use.
